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




The SME Policy Index Methodology

- ■Policy dimensions derived from the **SELA study** <u>Estudio de actualización del Índice de Políticas</u> <u>Públicas para Pymes en América Latina y el Caribe (IPPPALC)</u>
- ■Broken down into sub-dimensions and **measurable policy indicators** which are structured around **6** levels of policy development
- ■Two parallel assessments to obtain the
 - information and identify the level:
 - self-assessment by the government; and
 - independent assessment.



The level assessment are based on both quantitative and qualitative indicators.

Example: Turkey

Sub-dimension: **Legal and Regulatory Framework**

Dimension: Access to Finance


Score: **3.89**

Assessment: Turkey is in the implementation phase



- Based on assessment grid with questions (qualitative and quantitative data)
- Questions are presented in three groups in line with the policy cycle:
 - Planning and design
 - Implementation
 - Monitoring and evaluation
- Each question is linked to a score given by group of experts.
- Various weights could be provided to each group of questions (thematic block) and sub-dimension

Advantages of the Methodology

- It captures the quality of planning, implementation and monitoring of SME policies, and thus goes beyond the pure existence of strategies and programmes.
- It incorporates qualitative and quantitative questions to provide a more precise assessment for each indicator.
- It integrates national statistics, company-level and independent company-surveys to measure the **performance** of policies on the ground.
- It supports governments in assessing themselves whether they
 have reached their targets on SME policies and puts an increased
 focus on monitoring and evaluation.
